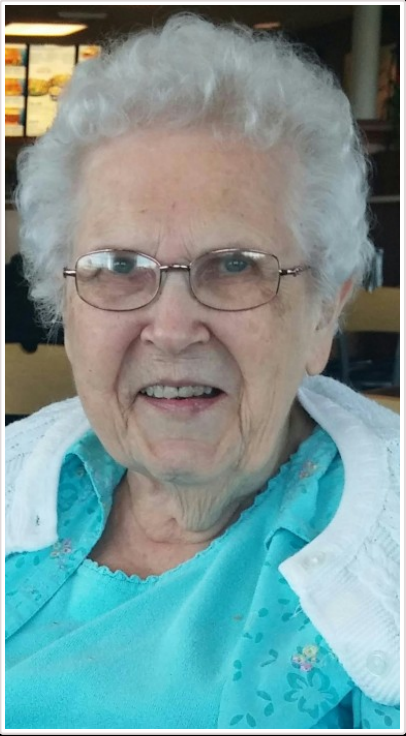


Naomi M. Schroeder (Grilliot)
